Session Description

Museums and other institutions have been responsive to the work of artists and scholars by putting thousands of images online. While there is a variance in what access is allowed, Amsterdam's Rijksmuseum shines in the face of this movement. Come take a tour of the Rijksstudio, which not only makes images accessible, it has provided a maker space with a variety of options, and encouraged makers with contests. This session outlines the variances of some of the contributors, and highlights the features of the Rijksstudio. Participants will also learn how to get their own studios.

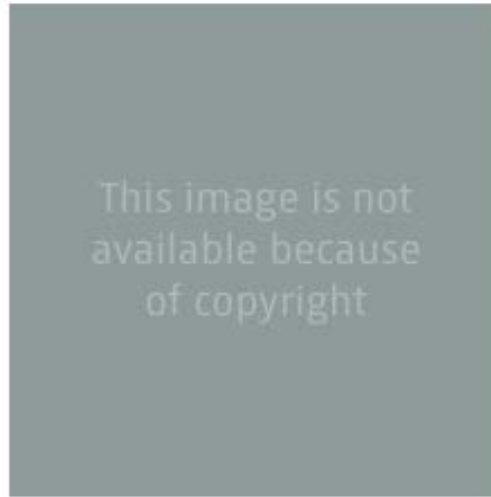

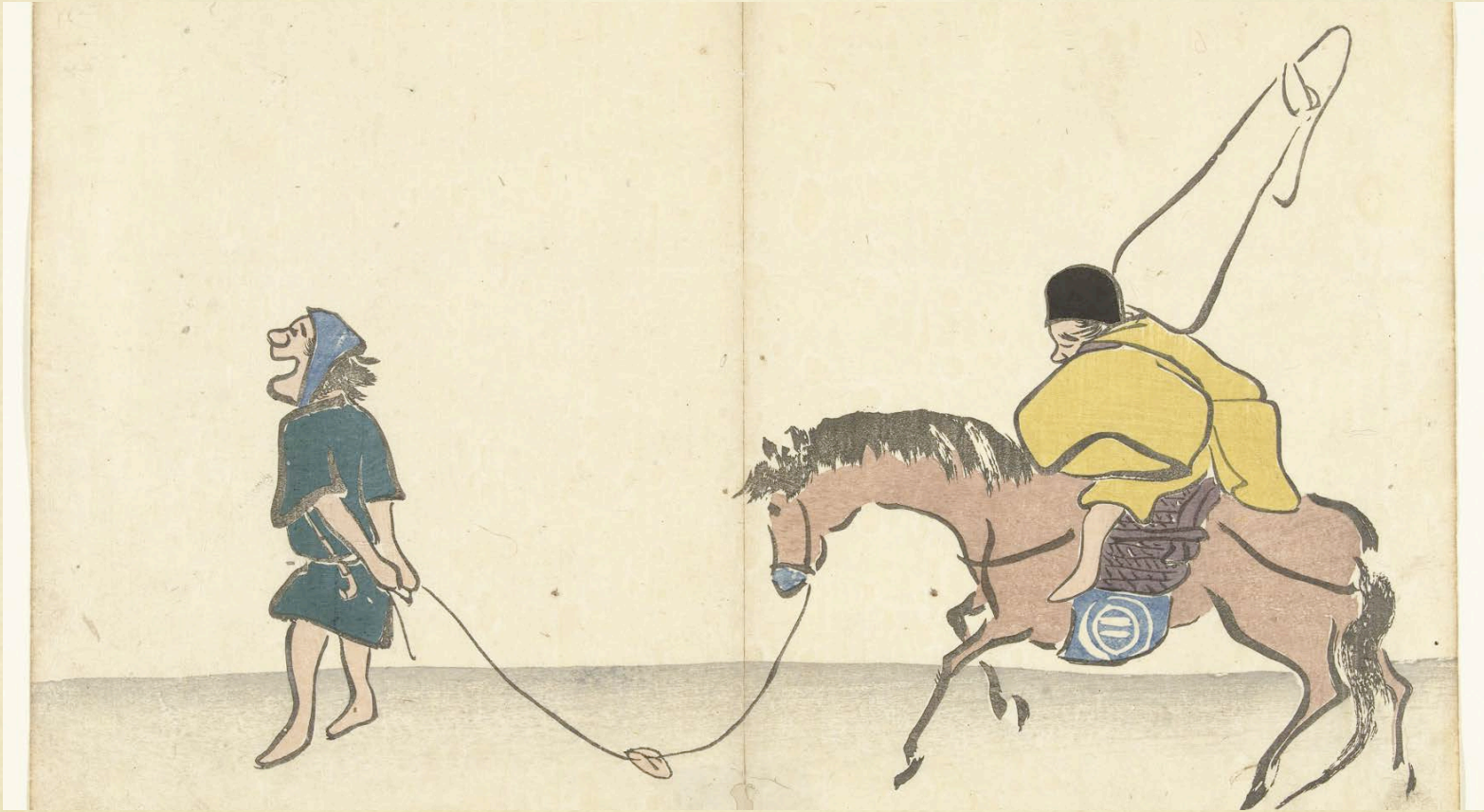

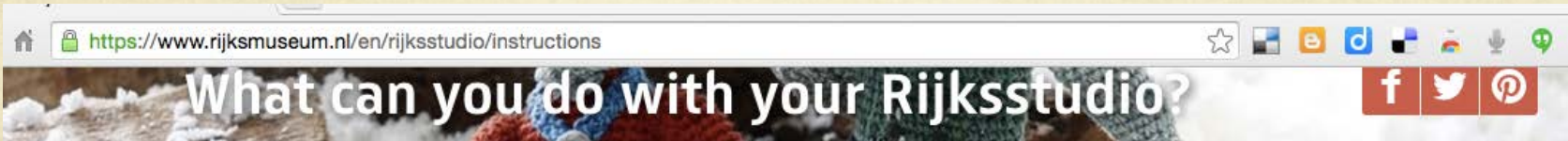
Still Life with Fish

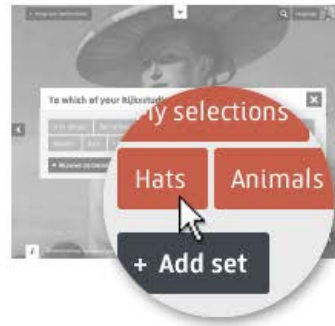


Finding Images Creating Sets

3. The (detail of the) artwork will be saved in your Rijksstudio.



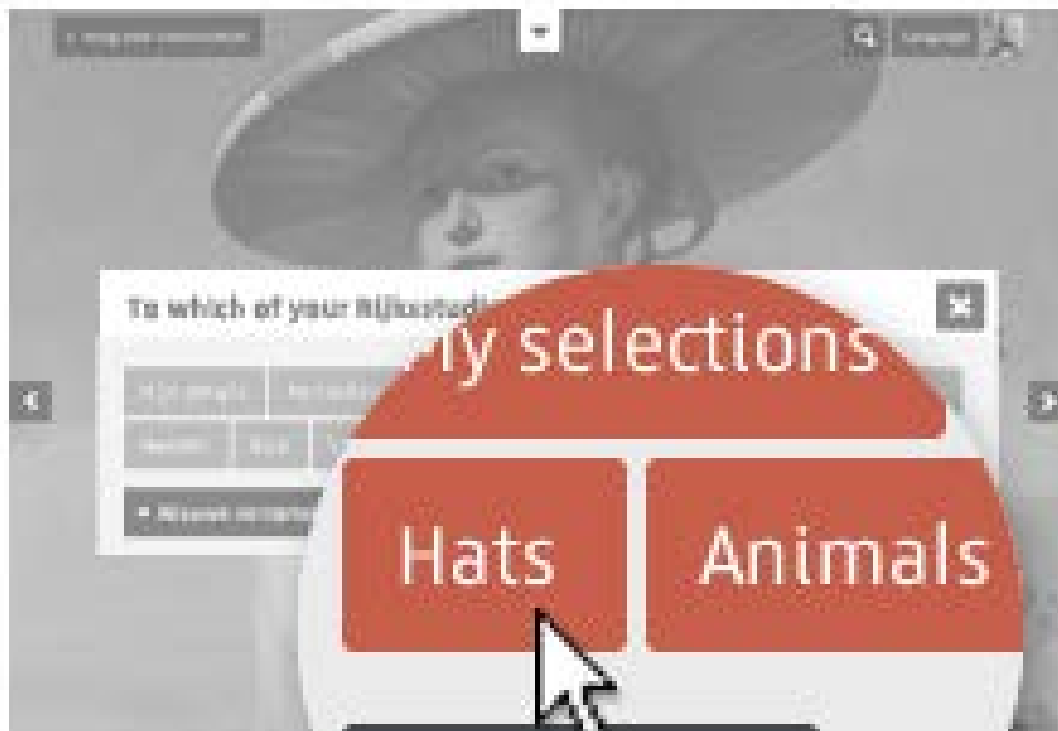

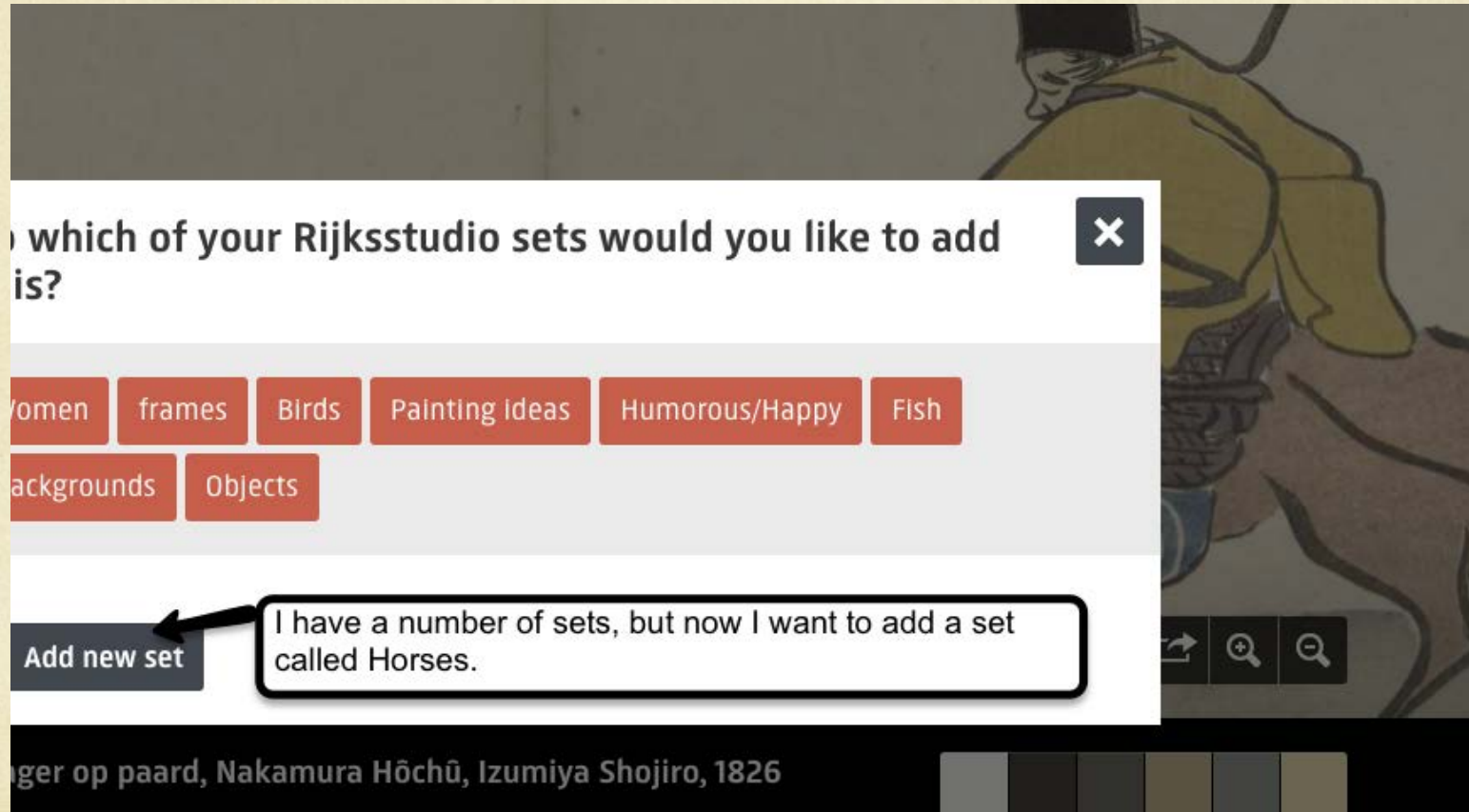


